Advocate Nakul Patil, founder chairman of Thane Zilla Agari Shikshan Prasarak Mandal was the visionary and passionate leader to initiate the educational institution in the city of Dombivli of Thane district. It is known as a city of learned people in the state of Maharashtra. Pragati College is his brain child established on 27th June 1997. The college started growing up very fast within a decade and onwards. Inculcation of values among the students was the major concern of the entire managing committee especially Nakulji Patil. Several activities were organised under his guidance. After his demise in 2011, this platform was established to continue with his dream of inculcating values. Since last many years Manch is organizing various activities on his birth and death anniversaries in the month of June and September. This year 'Patriotism' was the theme selected for activities. Patriotic singing Competition, slogan writing and wall magazine competitions were organised on 26th and 27th of June, 2019, around 30 students have been participated in the competitions.

On 1st July a programme was organised to commemorate the death anniversary of Nakulji Patil. Mr. Madhukar Chakradeo, a well known social figure in the city was the chief invitee who spoke on the active role of Late Mr. Patil in the development of the city.
